- Artwork Types: We welcome a diverse range of media, including painting, sculpture, photography, digital art, fibers, prints, mixed media, and installations.
- Theme: Artwork should respond to themes of ecological grief, climate change, environmental loss, and hope for the future.
- Entry Fee: None
- Quantity Limitations: 3 maximum entries.
- Submission Requirements:
 - Digital Images: Submit high-quality jpegs of your work. For questions about resolution contact Jonathan Gibson gibsonj1@xavier.edu.
 - Size Restrictions: Maximum size is 36" x 48"
 - Weight Restrictions: Maximum weight is 30lbs.
 - Media Restrictions: Painting, drawing, digital prints, collage, photography, sculpture, ceramics, fibers, printmaking, and illustration.
 - Artist Statement: A brief statement (200 words max.) describing the work and its relation to the theme.

Selection Process:
