2017 CINCO INNOVATIVE EDUCATOR AWARD

XAVIER MHSA CELEBRATES 60 YEARS

Established in 1958, our Xavier MHSA program celebrates 60 years this year. Back in 1958 when our program started, the "new" profession of hospital administration was just getting underway at the University of Chicago as a result of Dr. Malcolm T. MacEachern's 1,316-page book, HOSPITAL ORGANIZATION AND MANAGEMENT published in 1935. Xavier was only the 15th hospital administration program in the country back in 1958. We've had six program directors over the years: **James Martin** (deceased) 1968-1965 with 34 graduates; **Dr. Ed Arlinghaus** (deceased) 1966-1992 with 811 graduates; **Dr. Al Bocklet** acting director in 1992-1993 after Dr. Arlinghaus passed away with 59 graduates; **Dr. Bob Ludtke** 1993-1998 with 234 graduates; **Dr. Ida Schick** 1998-2011 with 321 graduates; and **Sister Dr. Nancy Linenkugel** since 2011 with 208 graduates and 79 current students.
