## What is Project SEARCH?

Project SEARCH is a one-year transition to work program that prepares students with disabilities for employment. The immersive workplace training program combines classroom instruction, career exploration, and hands-on learning through actual business partner worksite rotations.

Project SEARCH provides students with disabilities real-life work experience and employability training. Students also learn about independent-living skills needed for a successful transition to adult life. Students who complete the program can find employment in career paths that match their skills and interests.

Project SEARCH is designed to provide students with a variety of worksite experiences. During the school year, students rotate through three non-paid internship sites to learn work skills needed for the world of work. The goal of Project SEARCH is that students will find and maintain competitive employment.
