Report of Administration: President Hanycz

- High level updates:
 - Just finished a 20-year campus master plan, new campus master plan underway
 - Finishing that plan this summer
 - Student Success Project
 - Focused on why students stay at Xavier or depart from Xavier
 - College of Osteopathic Medicine
 - Opening in the fall of 2027; 600 medical students but will ease our way into things per the accreditation process
 - New science building as phase 2 of this project

- Q&A:
- Q: Do you have any plans to renovate or remove current science buildings in academic mall?
- A: No great plans for that but ideas are being circulated.

- Q: Are there plans to construct a new dorm?
- A: Looking into additional residence space whether that be on campus or off campus, not in the immediate future. Looking into finding a strip on campus to house a new entertainment district or the idea of a college town.

- Q: Any plans in the master plan to create a new track?
- A: On the same level of a football team where new construction of a stadium would require thoughts into a new track

- Q: What can SGA do on our end to help with student involvement and what are some potential solutions to our retention shortcomings?
- A: Living in such a digital age makes it unclear as to what engagement truly looks like. Because of this, it has become harder to engage a student. The inclination to engage has shifted over time throughout generations. COVID has also contributed to engagement. We must truly understand how to engage students and go about it in different ways. My view of your world is different than yours. My idea would be to have more opportunities for smaller groups to do their thing. Be led by the data, and not assume that everyone here has the same perspective.

- Q: What are some steps you can take as the University President to direct civic discourse given the nature of the election coming up?
- A: The Take It On program implements it well but there is a need to model a sense of openness to different views. Hateful speech is not worthy of being protected when it comes to contentious topics. Listen to the values and the views of the person across the table from you. I'm okay with debates and counter speech as long as it maintains respect.

- Q: How are differentiating the new "More Xavier" +x branding from the classic "X" logo?
- A: the famous "X" has remarkable brand recognition across the country. What you're seeing with "More Xavier" is the introduction of a new font which works with the "plus x" branding. It also introduces a playful interplay with new colors. The yellow and light

blue will continue, but we would never veer into our classic trademark in a way that would hurt the school.
