Report of Administration: Dr. Plassmann, Dean of College of Arts and Sciences

- Academic projects in the making
- 4 new B.S., 1 new B.A. programs
- New programs in the humanities (i.e. applied and medical) and new minors/concentrations in diplomacy, prelaw, constitutional studies
 - Fully active by next fall
- Working on new major in game design out of the arts department
- Building graduate program in instructional design through online teaching; needed for master's programs in professional schools
 - o Entirely online, focused in development
- Full year scheduling idea
 - Seeing class options a year in advance rather than only a semester in advance
 - Helps assess costs farther in advance; requires curriculum to be planned out
