- Legalization of recreational use of marijuana (21+): Implications on campus?
 - University policy on alcohol and drugs has NOT changed; compliance with federal law to maintain federal funding
 - On campus students: will be held accountable if done on campus
 - Off campus students who are over 21 and not bringing back on campus: not held accountable
 - No contact policy between parties who reported
- Handbook student conduct update
 - Suspension language: obedience; suspension can be held in a paused state so long as they apply with other conditions of their suspension
