- Summary of her role as Dean of Students
- VP of Student Affairs Role
 - Will be in the senior leadership
 - Student experience and advocacy for students will be considered every time an important decision will be made
- **Q:** Details about the renovations of The Store
 - o Repairs caused by a broken pipe over break
 - o \$50,000 from Crosstown Foodout
 - This will go to stylistic renovations
 - o Satellite stores carry less items, probably no perishables
 - They do have health and beauty products
 - This is a relatively new addition
- **Q:** Most common Title 9 complaint
 - o Disclaimer: Kate Lawson is the chief officer, she would know better
 - o Increased reporting in sex discrimination, this doesn't mean that sex discrimination is increasing just the people who are reporting has increased
 - Mostly student-to-student, interpersonal interactions
 - Title 9 covers incidents that are not caused by someone who attends or works at Xavier
- **Q:** How will football change Xavier?
 - Changes in NCAA regulations may be seeing how that shakes out before moving forward
 - Not much information
- **Q:** What will the process of moving forward with the Strategic Plan look like?
 - o Forum to talk about the roll out of the StratPlan in February
 - Developing a Transformitve Student Experience
